Email submission guidelines for Third Parties

Email PVA submission guidelines for Third Parties

- Third parties may use email to submit Postal Vote Applications (PVAs) to the AEC through their scanning provider Computershare. All submissions **must** adhere to the following guidelines.
- Failure to follow the guidelines will result in the email being **rejected**, meaning the Postal Vote Application will **not** be received by Computershare.

Email must have:

<p>Subject Line Format:</p>	<p>The subject line must include the mandatory details of the PVA, these are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Date and time the PVA was received by third party • Originating state • Political party <p>Subject line must follow the format below:</p> <p>NOTE: If you are an independent or third party not listed below, it is important you list 'OTH' as the PVA source code. 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<p>Email Size:</p>	<p>30MB is the MAXIMUM email size.</p> <p>Emails that exceed the size limit will receive an '<i>Undeliverable</i>' email.</p>								
<p>PVA limit per email:</p>	<p>A maximum of 20 <u>single-sided</u> PVAs can be attached to a single email.</p> <p>DO NOT send the back of the PVA. This will make the attachment size too large.</p>								

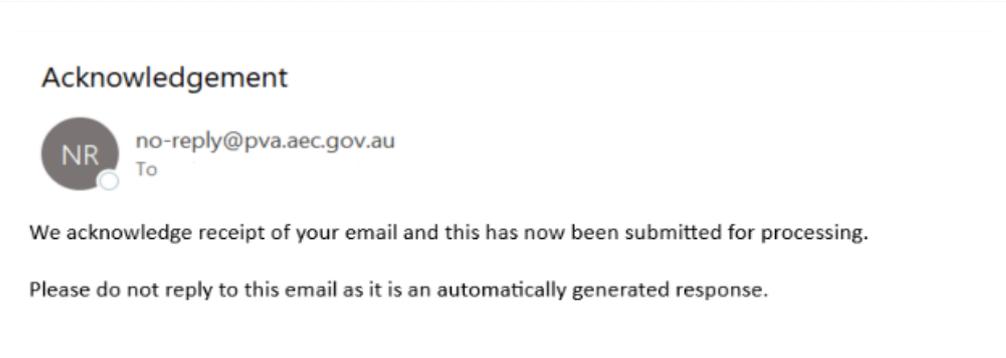
<p>PVA scanning requirement:</p>	<p>PVAs must be scanned and configured as below before being attached to the email.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Scan Resolution: 300dpi • Scan Colour: Greyscale • Compression: JPEG

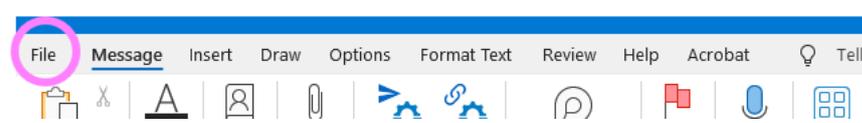
If your email has been sent successfully, you will receive an automatic email acknowledgement from Computershare (as shown on the top row of the table below).

<p>How can I check the size of my email?</p>	<p>In outlook, have your email draft open and click <i>file</i></p>  <p>Here you can see the email properties and the size, make sure it is smaller than 30MB</p>

<p>How do I make my scan resolution 300dpi?</p>	<p>You can change the scanning resolution on your scanning device before you scan.</p>
<p>How do I make the PVA scan in Greyscale?</p>	<p>Use the <i>grayscale</i> option on your scanning device.</p> <p>Do not use the <i>black and white</i> option or the <i>auto detect</i> option.</p>
