I wish to object to the proposed name change of the federal Victorian electorate of Corangamite to the name of Tucker.

It seems Tucker is the surname of an indigenous person of the Yorta Yorta tribe from the Murray River area and this lady is renown in the area as an activist of some note. Corangamite is adjacent to the Geelong Region and encompasses large swathes of Geelong city itself. The name itself is recognizable and locally endorsed by the ALP, Green and Liberal parties.

I myself and members of the Ocean Grove/Queenscliff branch of the ALP would rather we retain the name Corangamite in preference to an unrelated name such as Tucker.

I would therefore be pleasded if your office would leave the name as is.
