I would like to submit my strong objection to the change of boundary name of Corangamite to Tucker.

Firstly, I see no valid reason why the change of name is necessary from "Corangamite" which is of aboriginal origin and refers directly to our district to the name of "Tucker". In my opinion this is not of aboriginal origin but the activist to which the name refers is known as "Aunty Marg" and is associated to the Northern parts of Victoria.

Also, the word "Tucker" is readily likened to bush tucker rather than Mary Tucker and is not appealing in any way to myself being a resident of Corangamite for most of my life. Whereas Corangamite refers to Lake Corangamite, being the largest lake in Victoria, which most in our district know of.

The name change to Tucker is not appropriate and would not represent our community division's name change any better than Corangamite and would be more suited to a northern boundary electorate.
