Tucker is a very generic name which runs the risk of becoming a shared honour at a later date eg with a future Prime Minister named Tucker. Lilardia on the other hand is unique to her, respects her Indigenous heritage by honouring the name that was stolen from her when she was stolen from her parents, and its uniqueness might make up a little bit for the loss of the name Corangamite. I'm also wondering if Corangamite is the best seat to be replaced, or if there's a better seat that could be renamed to either Tucker or Lilardia given Corangamite's place as one of only a few Federation seats with an Indigenous name? I'm sensing some pushback against the loss of that name? You're replacing one Indigenous naming honour with another, but how obvious is that to the wider community who aren't following this redistribution?
