1) I object to changing the Division of Corangamite to Tucker, on the following reasons;

Corangamite is already recognised as an Aboriginal name and gives respect to the people who lived in the Western District of the State of Victoria.

Corangamite is a word from the Colijon people language along with other Aboriginal people, Jarcourt, Keeraywurrong and Wathaurong peoples.

As Margaret (Lilardia) Elizabeth Tucker was a Yorta Yorta woman, why is there not an amendment to the Divisions of Indi and Nicholls to better reflect where Ms Tucker was born and established her significant work from.

It would appear your proposed change removes any Aboriginal heritage from the Corangamite Division.

2) I object to the recommendation of a new Division named Hawke, on the following reasons'

Rober James Hawke was a known womaniser, of which he has never denied whilst living. This recommendation does not reflect the current societal view of the respect given to women then and the new Division name appears to endorse the misogynist view. Because he was a Prime Minister, is not an automatic reason to name a Division after him.

I therefore disapprove the Redistribution Committee's proposals.
