

Annual Donor Disclosure Return Individuals

FINANCIAL YEAR 2021-22

Sections 305B and 306 of the *Commonwealth Electoral Act 1918* (Electoral Act) require donors to furnish a return within 20 weeks after the end of the financial year.

The due date for lodging this return is 17 November 2022.

Completing the Return:

- This return is to be completed by a person who made a donation to a registered political party (or a State branch), significant third party, member of the House of Representatives (MP) or Senator.
- This return is to be completed with reference to the Financial Disclosure Guide for Annual Donors.
- This return will be available for public inspection from 1 February 2023 at www.aec.gov.au.
- Any supporting documentation included with this return may be treated as part of a public disclosure and displayed on the AEC website.
- The information on this return is collected under s 305B and s 306 of the Electoral Act.
