FINANCIAL YEAR 2022-23

The due date for lodging this return is 17 November 2023.

- Amounts should be reported on a GST inclusive basis.
- This return will be available for public inspection from 1 February 2024 at <a href="www.aec.gov.au">www.aec.gov.au</a>.
- Any supporting documentation included with this return may be treated as part of a public disclosure and displayed on the AEC website.
- The information on this return is collected under section 314AED of the Electoral Act.
