Dear Madams / Sirs

I propose that that

1. the northern electorate be named **Ngunnawal** as I understand it the first nation's name for the country hereabouts,
2. the southern electorate be named **Bean**, and
3. the central electorate be named **Fenner** as this is the usual 'range' for the noteworthy medical professor at the ANU and, what I have been informed the past, home in the inner south.

I propose that that Canberra is (effectively) the generic name for the territory and the Federal government / parliament and the whole of its city, its territory or residents. So therefore is not suitable nor effective as an appropriate name for any one federal electoral division alone. It is also a target name for misrepresentation of the responsible parties in any federal parliamentary decision.

Ngunnawal is also a name for a suburb in Gungahlin, which is also in the northern part of the ACT; and **Fenner** is also a name for an ANU residential building, in case other uses the names are relevant.
