I write to you asking that you keep the Corangamite Electoral boundaries unchanged. Colac needs to be associated with Geelong, not Warrnambool. Colac residents have little affinity with Warrnambool, but have much in common with Geelong. This has come about through the hard work, over many years, of G21 which has been of great benefit to Colac and we wish this to continue. We rely on it! We are not aligned to Warrnambool but we are synonymous with Geelong.

If the proposed boundary change is made then Colac's identity with Corangamite—a Federation Seat, is lost, which would be a most unfortunate occurrence.

The name Corangamite is an Indigenous word and should be kept at all costs, for all time. Please do not change the name of Corangamite!

Please consider Colac's longtime alliance with Geelong and leave the Electorate of Corangamite as it currently stands, and has stood since 1901. I strongly object to any change in any way.

Warrnambool is alien compared to Geelong.
