To the AEC re: proposed redistribution boundaries for the seat of Corangamite.

Having considered both the redistribution of Corangamite and surrounding electorates of Wannon, Corio, etc there are significant economic, social and environment benefits for the proposed redistribution. A stronger sense of communities of interest will ensure with the inclusion of the Bellarine Peninsula and the realignment of the rural focussed communities to the west of the State.

This proposed retribution gives a stronger focus on the coastal communities and will further build on the significant community connections that already exist. Many of these communities are experiencing significant population growth and the ensuring infrastructure needs. In addition these communities are experiencing increased tourism which places additional pressure on the coastal communities and the environment. The impact of climate changes and rising sea levels are issues these communities will increasing need to deal with.

With the respect to the naming of the proposed seat, I would like consideration and further consultation with Aboriginal and Torres Strait communities as the original inhabitants of these lands. I believe some people have proposed Barrabool and I would urge further consideration of this name.
