I wish to lodge my objection to the proposed redistribution of the Corangamite electorate.

It is neither practical or sensible to split Colac Otway Shire between two electorates. How does council effectively govern and engage with federal agencies if the shire is split between two electorates? The council would need to deal with two separate MP's for federal funding, which would be an unfair impost on a small council.
