I am helping put the case to honour General Sir John Monash with an electorate name change.

Until a few years ago, I was ignorant of who the man really was and what he achieved and I was appalled to discover that this ignorance was widespread. Monash was born in the electorate and served in it after his amazing efforts on the Western Front. He is credited with winning WW1 and that claim is not far off being absolute truth.
