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# **SUGGESTIONS ON THE REDISTRIBUTION OF FEDERAL ELECTORAL BOUNDARIES IN VICTORIA**

## ***General Remarks***

This submission to the Redistribution Committee has been produced in response to the Committee's call for suggestions on the redistribution of Federal electoral boundaries in Victoria. I am an independent analyst and election expert; I am not a member of any political party and have no political interest at stake in the redistribution process. However, I believe that it is important for the functioning of democracy that citizens should contribute in matters where they have relevant expertise, so my hope is that some of my suggestions might be useful to the Committee.

The increase in Victoria's entitlement from 37 to 38 divisions has in some ways made the Committee's task easier. The lack of uniformity in Victoria's growth, with rural and middle-suburban areas in relative decline and high growth in the outer suburbs and some inner urban areas, means that significant adjustments would be necessary in any case. With an extra division in play, the risk of having to abolish a division somewhere in the low-growth zone diminishes. In fact, as this submission demonstrates, it is possible to satisfy the numerical constraints of the legislation very well while preserving 37 divisions that are clearly identifiable with their existing counterparts.

The new division is inevitably going to be located somewhere in the northern and western suburbs of Melbourne, where high growth is having most impact. My proposed creation, based on the City of Brimbank, I have called "Burke", after Robert O'Hara Burke, the leader of the Victorian Exploring Expedition of 1860-61. It is in the same general area as the division of that name that existed from 1969 to 2004, when it was replaced by Gorton.

Otherwise I have used for convenience the names of existing divisions, but I do so without making any judgement about their appropriateness. I am aware that concerns have been raised that certain historical figures after whom divisions are named do not deserve such commemoration; I should not be taken to express any opinion either way on the merits of those arguments.

One general consideration that the Committee should note at the outset is the imbalance between the north and the south of the state. The 19 divisions that lie generally north of the Yarra River and the mountains have projected 2019 enrolments of 20.23 times the

average; the other 18, only 17.77. Even after the creation of a new division in the north, voters in the south will enjoy an advantage in representation. The imbalance is not impossibly large, and the existing "northern" area could be divided into 20 divisions that met the statutory criteria, but my view is that such a systematic dilution of the weight of a particular set of voters should be avoided. I therefore recommend that territory should be transferred somewhere from a "northern" division to a "southern" one; the most logical place for this to happen is around the upper reaches of the Yarra, feeding into the northern part of Casey. On my proposals this involves about 23,000 electors, mostly from Scullin but with some from Indi and McEwen.

In what follows will be found details of the construction of each of my 38 proposed divisions, broken down by Level 2 Statistical Areas (SA2s) in the same way as the Committee's enrolment projections, with both raw numbers and percentages of average enrolment. A table at the beginning summarises the enrolments for existing and proposed divisions, and a set of sketch maps at the end illustrates their general shape. The proposed new boundaries generally follow suburb, SA2 or local government area (LGA) boundaries; an appendix to the descriptions provides an explanation for cases in which SA2s are split between two or more divisions.

The calculations of elector numbers are based on whole Level 1 Statistical Areas (SA1s)\*, but in a small number of cases these only approximate to the actual recommended boundaries as described. The need to split SA1s, which in the new Australian Statistical Geography Standard have taken over the role previously played by Census Collector Districts, will introduce small discrepancies in the elector numbers, but they are unlikely to be significant.

Unlike SA1s, LGAs define important administrative boundaries and can generally be taken as a good guide to community of interest. The proposed boundaries in this submission reduce the number of LGAs that are divided between two or more divisions. However, there are cases where deviating from an LGA boundary better satisfies the other criteria of the Act: a long-standing example is the use of the Yarra River, rather than the LGA boundary, to separate Melbourne and Melbourne Ports. A further consideration with LGA boundaries is a small number of fragments, containing very few or no electors, that have become detached from the rest of their LGA or SA2 due to minor discrepancies between the two either now or in the past. In what follows I have reallocated them as seemed sensible, but have not generally drawn attention to them or tried to work out the exact spot at which the discrepancy arose.

It will be noted that the proposals succeed in satisfying the numerical criteria of the Act and achieving substantial equality between divisions, thus ensuring as far as possible that every person's vote will have equal influence in electing members of parliament. On the projected enrolments, all but two of my 38 proposed divisions are within two per cent of the average, and 29 of them are within one per cent.

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\* With the exception of one SA1 on the Bellarine Peninsula, #3105166, which I made an educated guess to split between Corio and Corangamite in order to avoid a lack of contiguity.

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*Ballarat needs to lose a small amount of territory, and the Daylesford area (basically the eastern half of the Shire of Hepburn) seems to fit the bill well: its transport links tie it to the Calder Highway corridor just as much as to Ballarat, and it will sit well with Woodend, Kyneton and Castlemaine. (Although I have not attempted to distinguish them on the figures, I suggest following the shire boundary rather than the southern boundary of the SA2.) Ideally Bacchus Marsh would be moved to a metropolitan division, but there are too many electors involved for that to be accomplished without significant disruption to the west, and the current boundary at least keeps the whole of the Shire of Moorabool together.*

*Bruce is currently well below the required tolerance, and the growth in suburbs further out would pull it to the south-east in any case. I propose adding Doveton, Endeavour Hills and Hallam, which although in the City of Casey are more closely linked to Dandenong than to Berwick or Cranbourne. This enables Bruce to shed most of Glen Waverley, thus providing electors to Chisholm to balance its losses to Hotham. I propose also to regularise the south-western boundary so as to unite Springvale in Bruce and most of Noble Park in Hotham.*

*There is much to be said in the abstract for a general reconstruction of boundaries in the south-eastern suburbs (Bruce, Chisholm, Hotham and Isaacs), since the current configuration is unsatisfactory in a number of ways. I am unconvinced, however, that this is necessary at this point, so I have generally adopted a fairly minimalist approach to change in the area. I suspect this question will have to be revisited at the next redistribution, but by that time it is reasonably likely that further relative population decline in the middle south-eastern suburbs will clarify the options for change.*

*The state's highest growth rates are in the outer northern and western suburbs of Melbourne, so there is no doubt that the new division must be in this general area. My proposed "Burke" is not itself a high-growth division, but it is positioned centrally so that it can provide scope for growth in Calwell and Gorton, as well as indirectly in Lalor (via Maribyrnong and Gellibrand) and McEwen (via Calwell). It enjoys strong community of interest, being based on the Sunshine-St Albans-Sydenham corridor and mostly coextensive with the City of Brimbank.*

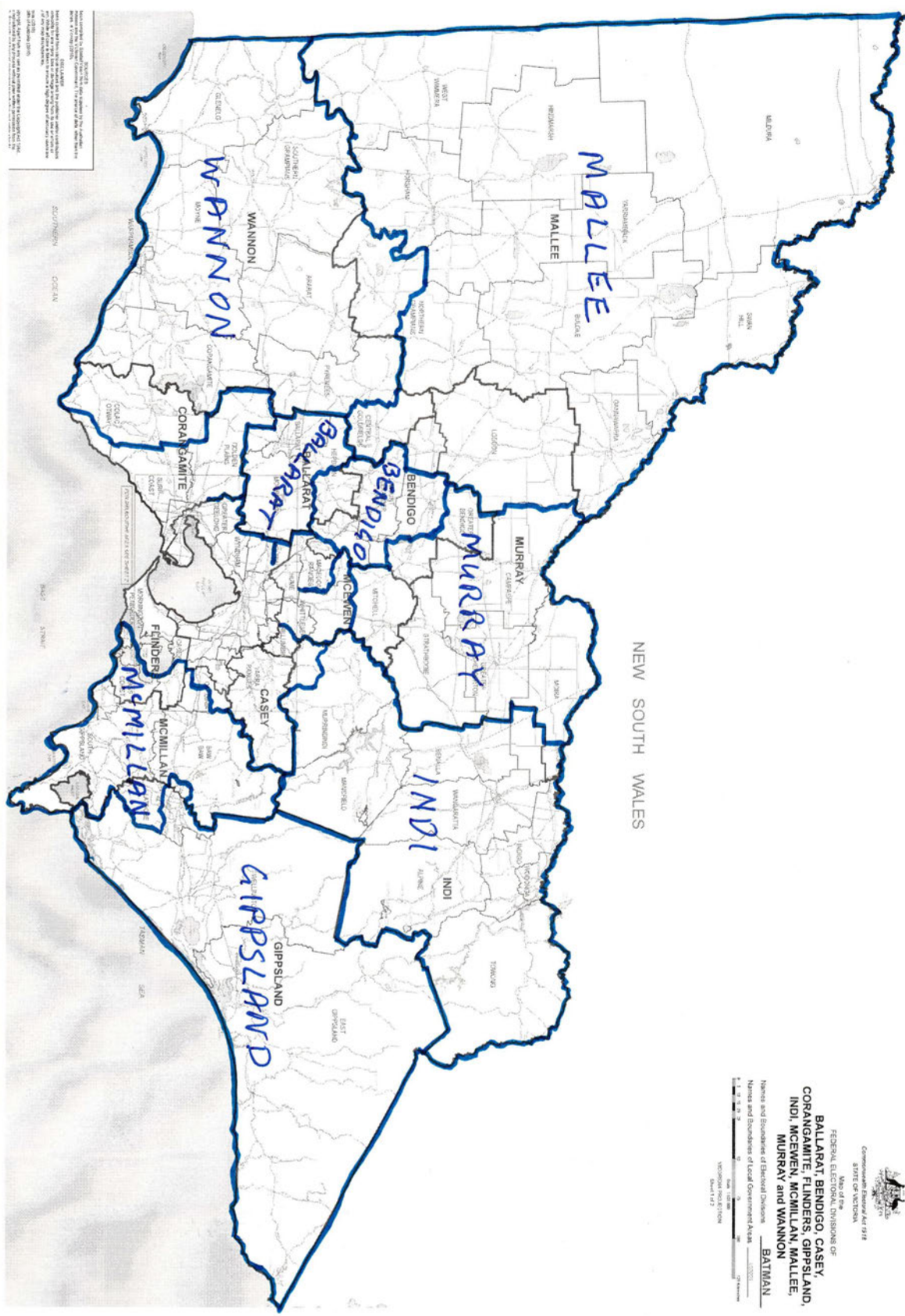

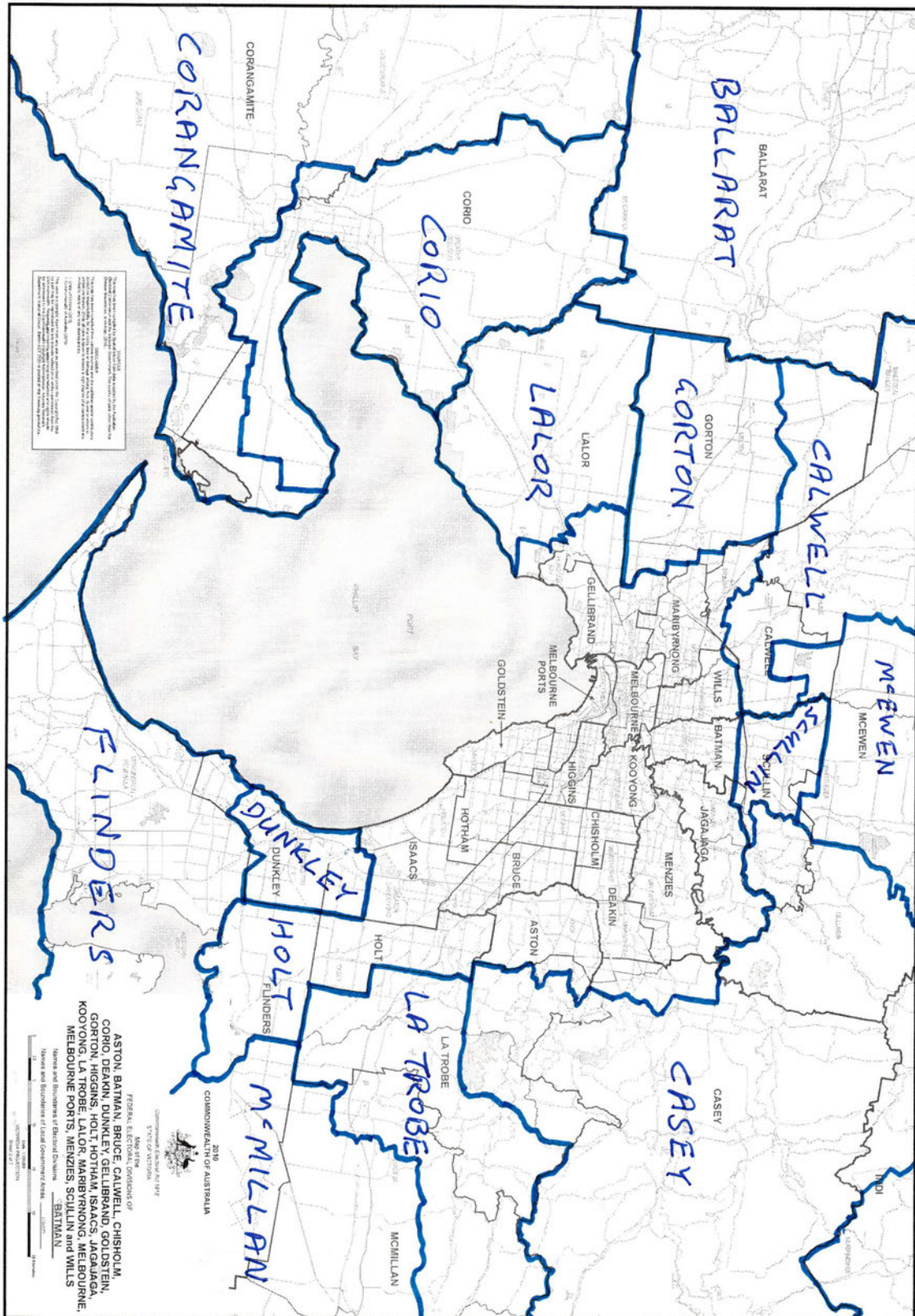
