I confirm that I submitted a formal written submission on 23 November 2023.

I have had the opportunity to examine the submissions on possible electoral boundary changes in NSW and particularly to the boundary of Warringah from Mr Alan Marel (objection reference #445). I advise that as a local resident of Freshwater I retain a significant connection to the area currently within the Warringah electorate in Dee Why and North Curl Curl for which there is a proposal to transfer to Mackellar. I am firmly of the view that any proposed changes should consider the clear geographical connection those areas proposed to be transferred have with all areas of Warringah to the south and there is no justification for the proposal in such circumstances. I fully support the submissions of Mr Marel in his objection.

I have again examined the submission by Ms Steggall (objection reference #671).

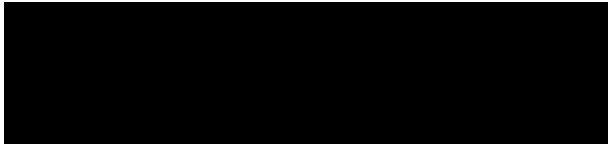
