Dear Commissioner,


We are writing to express our strong opposition to the proposed redistribution of the electoral area of Lindsay, specifically the inclusion of our community in Emu Heights, NSW, into the Macquarie division.

Having lived in Emu Heights for over eight years, we can attest to the deep connections our community has with the Penrith region. Our daily lives, including work, schooling, shopping, and social activities, are intrinsically tied to the Lindsay region. The shops, schools, transport links, and broader community services we rely on are all centered in and around Penrith.

In contrast, we have no significant connections to the Blue Mountains area. The proposed boundary change does not reflect the realities of our community's affiliations and daily interactions. It is our firm belief that such a change would undermine the integrity and cohesiveness of our community.

We urge you to rescind this proposal and maintain Emu Heights within the Lindsay division. The current arrangement accurately represents the social and economic ties of our community.

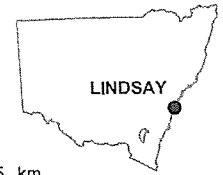

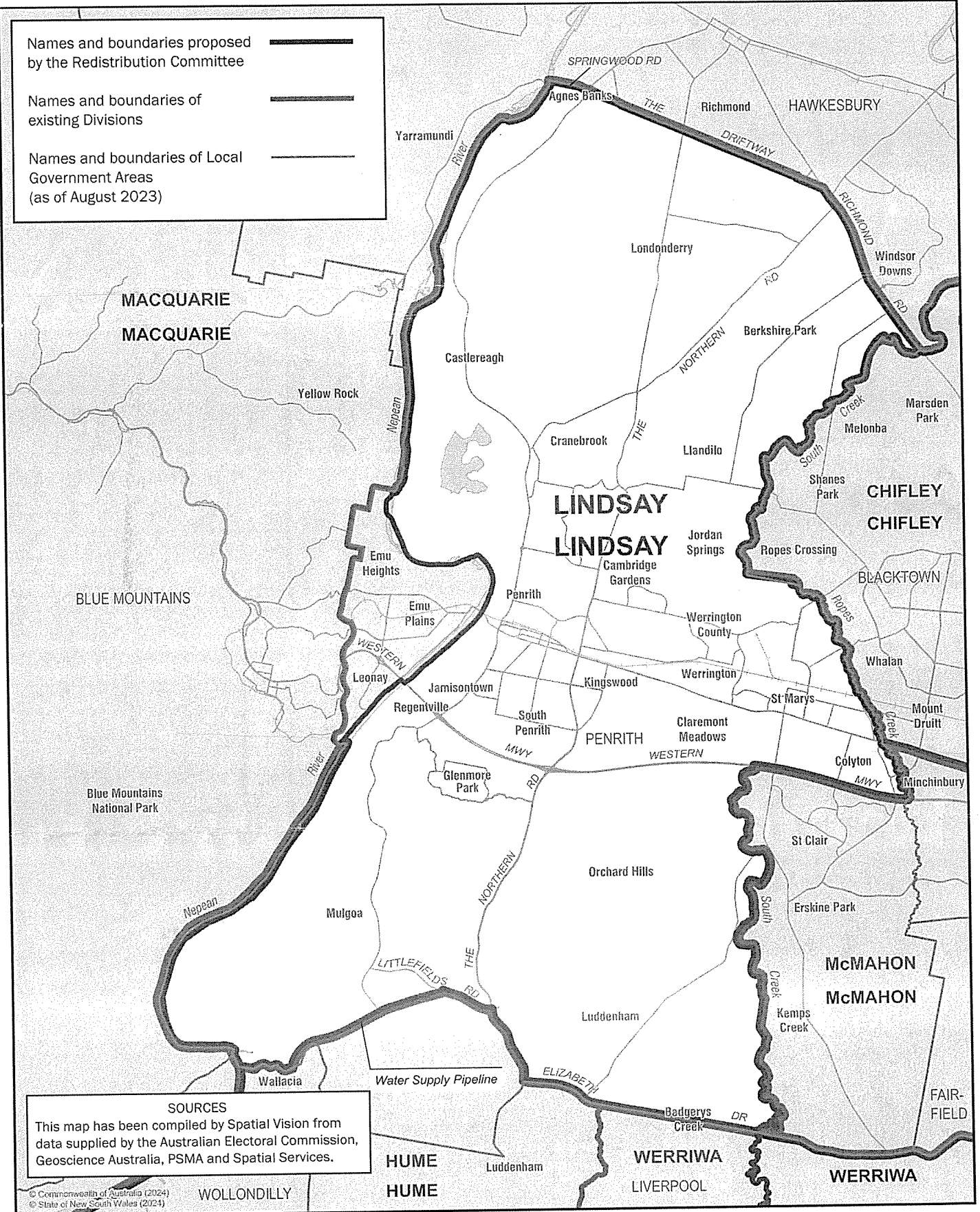
