The South Warrandyte Cricket Club is grateful for the opportunity to provide our thoughts on the proposed redistribution.

We are an active community cricket club based at Colman Park in Warrandyte South. We compete in the Ringwood & District Cricket Association (RDCA).

We are delighted that the Redistribution Committee has chosen to place Warrandyte South in the electorate of Deakin. We consequently disagree with those Objections seeking to oppose this change.

Our area is very closely connected to Warranwood, North Ringwood and Ringwood in the Deakin electorate. Our members predominantly live in the Deakin area, which is unsurprising given how connected we are to the suburbs that comprise Deakin.
