Dear AEC

I am objecting strongly to an aspect of the redrawing of the boundary for the Seat of Kooyong. It is proposed to put the boundary along Highfield Road in Camberwell. The Seat of Kooyong should continue to Warrigal Road and Toorak Road as there is little connection across Warrigal Road into the Seat of Chisholm. It makes no sense to end the new boundary at Highfield Road as those beyond this road, in the small area to Warrigal Road/Toorak Road, are oriented into the Camberwell/Hartwell area. You are totally dividing a community and are strongly urged to reconsider your divisive redrawing of the boundary.
